Discrepancies in lunch orders need to be addressed directly with Papa Saverio's as we only are involved in distributing the lunches according to the order list provided by Papa's.

Beginning November 1st, a lunch provided by the STS cafeteria will incur a cost of \$3.50. This fee will be charged through FACTs incidental billing on Fridays.
