

GOGUARDIAN

GoGaurdian is the Internet security platform that we use at St. Thomas School. It allows a teacher to see exactly what a student is looking at on their device. The teacher can then redirect a student if necessary or encourage the student to dig deeper. This program was paid for through a grant from the Illinois State Board of Education, but that grant is no longer available.





- Open Forum Q&A.












